

The 21st Century Is Here!!

Wood Badge is a two phase program for leaders who have completed the basic training for their registered position. The first phase uses unit meetings and an outdoor camping activity as a training ground for learning leadership skills. The second phase is developing a personal plan called a "ticket." The ticket gives the participant an opportunity to practice and develop the knowledge and leadership skills learned during the course. Participants will complete their tickets between 6 and 18 months after the course.

Recognition upon successful completion of the ticket is noted by awarding a certificate, the Wood Badge neckerchief and leather woogie, and the **"Wood Badge"** --two wooden beads worn on a leather thong around the neck. These symbols are recognized around the world as emblems of high achievement and dedication to the Scouting program.



The Official BSA uniform for your primary registered position is required for attendance. Course fees cover all food, training materials, insurance, and recognition. A current Class 3 physical is required for all participants.
