They are the parents of two daughters and one son. At age 30 he was elected to the first of his two four-year terms as Mayor of Gillette. He has served his county and state as a State Representative and was elected three times as a State Senator. He also served his country as a staff sergeant in the Wyoming Air National Guard. He was sworn in as Wyoming's 20th United States Senator

on January 7, 1997. Senator Enzi is an Eagle Scout, a Distinguished Eagle Scout, the father of an Eagle Scout and the grandfather of a Cub Scout.
